

2021 SEASON REQUIREMENTS

All mares arriving at Spendthrift Australia are required to provide the following documentation and adhere to protocol before we can breed your mare:

- All swabs must be less than 30 days old. Uterine Cultures or PCR Swabs, where required, must be taken from the current heat cycle.
- All maiden mares are to be jumped prior to their first visit and **hind shoes must be removed**.
- Spendthrift will make every reasonable attempt to breed your mare but reserves the right not to breed the mare at any given session if the mare is deemed a danger to the stallion and/or staff.
- A Hendra Virus vaccination certificate – if applicable, refer to the 2021 Hendra Virus Protocol.
- **Mares are to arrive with ID – neck strap or mane sticker for ease of identification - NO ID, NO COVER.**
- The Seasons Agreement Forms must be signed and returned to the office **prior** to the mare being covered.

Booking in mares for breeding:

Please allow us as much notice as possible prior to the preferred day for breeding your mare.

Whilst all possible efforts will be made to accommodate your preferred day and time, there will be occasions when a mare may be asked to be re-vetted at the mare's resident farm or asked to stay at Spendthrift briefly for an additional pre serve veterinary examination.

3. 45 day positive pregnancy test accompanied with a standard veterinary certificate
